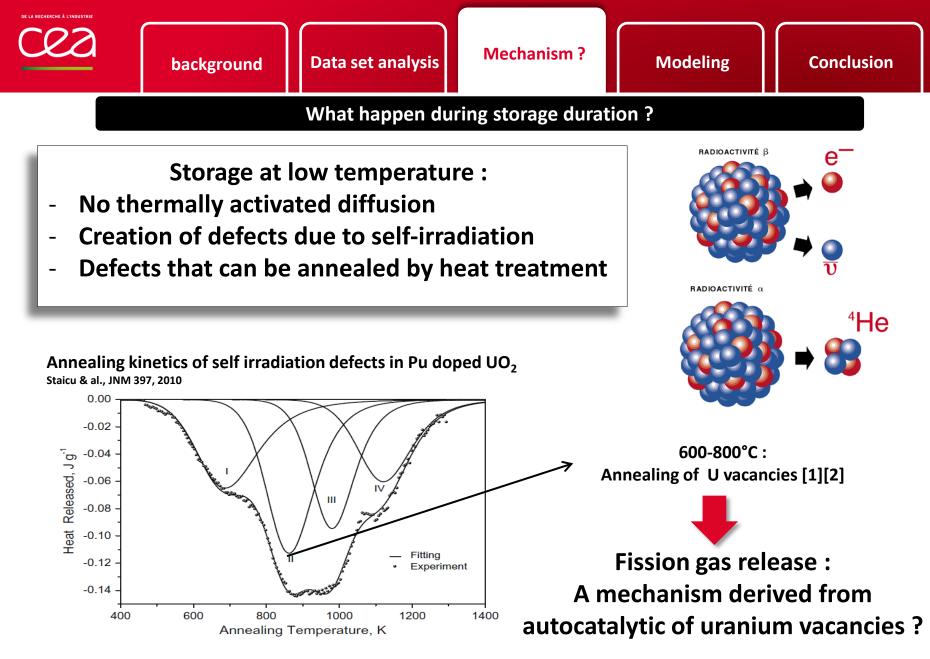


## Parameters of MERARG data set

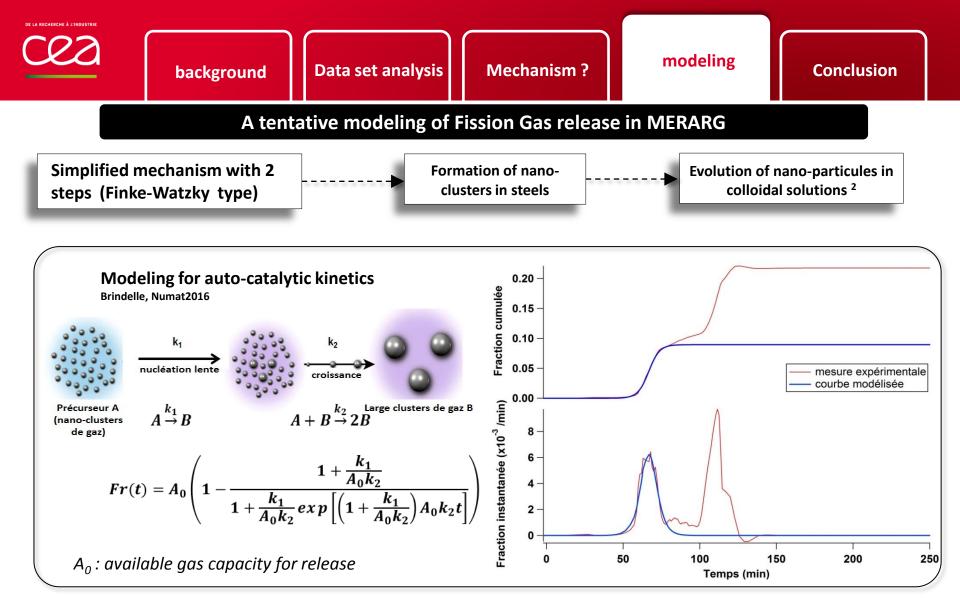
- From November 2000 up to nowadays more than 200 heat treatments in MERARG Which ones are relevant?
- Temperature profiles related to LOCA
- First plateau at 300°C and then temperature ramp in inert atmosphere.



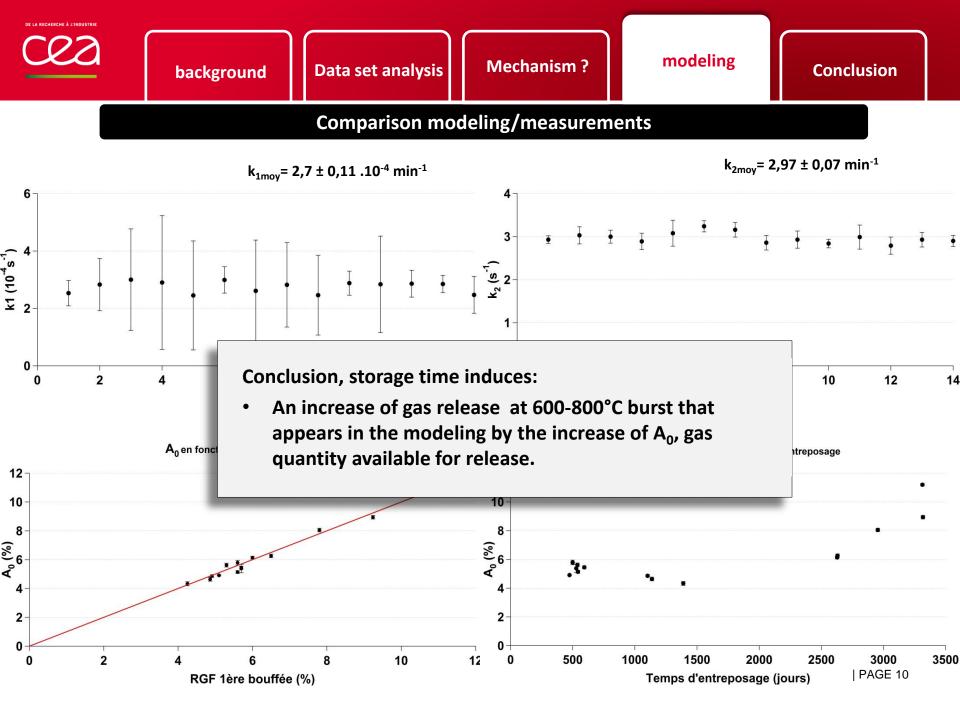


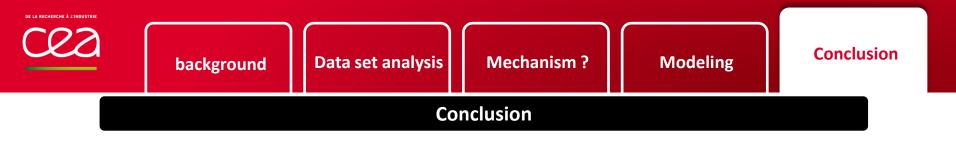

The quantity of gas release during the burst at 600-800°C depends on storage time.

The release mechanism could be due to the annealing of self-irradiation defects that were produced during storage. A kinetic model is proposed to describe this release mechanism.

The storage time is a first order parameter for gas release experiment that needs to be taken into account.
