Monoamides for U & Pu extraction ...

- → Innovative liquid-liquid extraction processes for the reprocessing of spent nuclear fuels
- \rightarrow Good stability towards radiolysis and hydrolysis

... But what about fission products extraction?





Technetium in the PUREX process

- > ⁹⁹Tc = Long-lived β emitting radionuclide (with a radioactive half-life of 2.1×10⁵ y)

Technetium in the PUREX process

- > ⁹⁹Tc = Long-lived β emitting radionuclide (with a radioactive half-life of 2.1×10⁵ y)

- Can cause some issues in the PUREX process if not correctly scrubbed (hydrazine destruction, U & Pu contamination)
- Measurements implemented in La Hague plant

Towards a new process ...

DEHiBA (N,N-di-2-ethylhexyl-isobutyramide) = promising extractant for future processes









Objectives:

Understanding the mechanisms involved in the extraction of technetium with DEHiBA

- Modeling technetium extraction
- Integrating the model into the CEA PAREX code to improve the modeling of extraction processes and help flowsheets design

Method:

- Free extractant concentration determined by an iterative method based on dichotomy resolution
- Calculation of U, Tc, H, H₂O concentrations in organic phase
- Optimization of the unkown parameter K by an iterative method based on least-squares analysis corresponding to the minimization of:

Pertechnetic acid HTcO₄ binary data = triplet (Φ_{HTcO4} , γ_{HTcO4} , m_{HTcO4})

Ceaden TECHNETIUM SPECIATION IN ORGANIC PHASE

IR spectroscopy combined with theoritical calculations (DFT)

- Optimisation of the UO₂(NO₃)(TcO₄)L₂ complex structure
- Vibrational frequencies calculation for UO₂(NO₃)₂L₂ and UO₂(NO₃)(TcO₄)L₂ complexes
- \rightarrow Confirmation that changes are occuring in the U(VI) inner coordination sphere when uranium and technetium are co-extracted
- \rightarrow Calculated UO₂(NO₃)(TcO₄)L₂ structure is used as support for XAS data processing
