The coverages in oxygen are $\theta_{\text{O}} = 0.25$ and $\theta_{\text{O}} = 0.50$. Also activation barriers (eV) for the penetration of hydrogen across the (110) clean surface of tungsten are reported from [17]. The rate limiting steps are displayed in bold for both the forward and backward diffusions mechanisms.
