## Motivations

- Millimetric resolution in the plasma edge
- Upper-half plasma coverage with some overlap between edge & core channels
- Real time measurements possible
- Temperature: 1 keV (pedestal) to few eV (far SOL)
- No ECE, Reflectometry or Interferometry measurement in the edge to resolve  $n_e$  profile

## Constraints

- Long pulse (1000 s) measurement.
- Reach millimetric resolution
- First mirror inside the vessel &  $\phi_{\text{pupil}} \sim 8 \text{ cm}$
- First mirror water cooled & all in-vessel optics protected by a thermal shield
- Shutter to protect the optics against glow discharges and boronization
- Best compromise:  $\phi_{\text{pupil}} \sim 8 \text{ cm}$  &  $\Delta z = 18 \text{ cm}$ .
- Optical vacuum feedthrough

## Specifications

- A probing zone from  $Z=0,47$  to  $Z=0,65 \text{ m}$  covers the pedestal and the SOL in most configurations
- 30 lines of sight :
  - ↳ 14 far SOL views monitored with simple fibres
  - ↳ 16 pedestal views monitored with duplexed fibres
- 6 mm height
- 7,5 mm toroidal width for each scattered volume

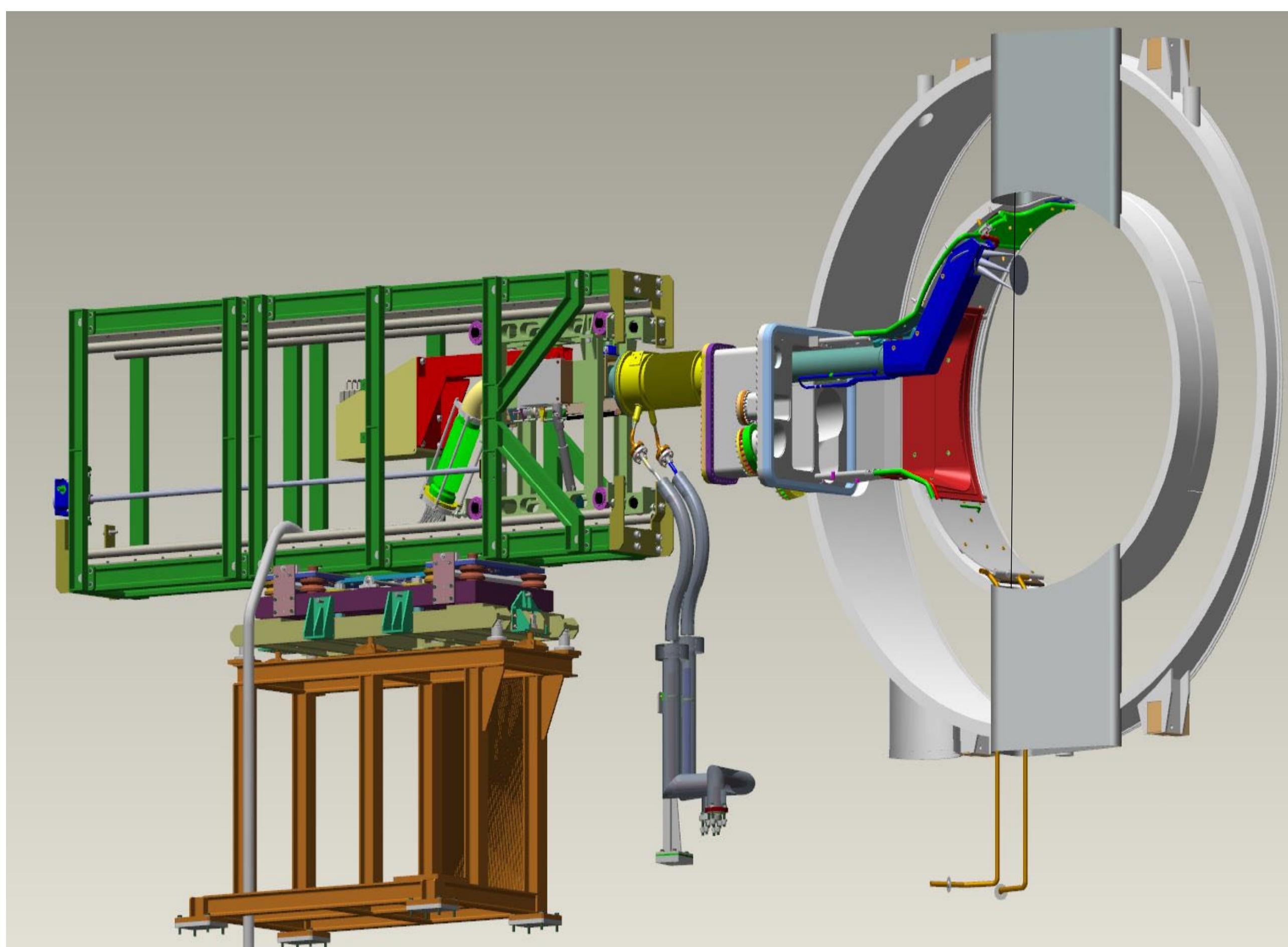


Fig 1. View of the Edge measurement system

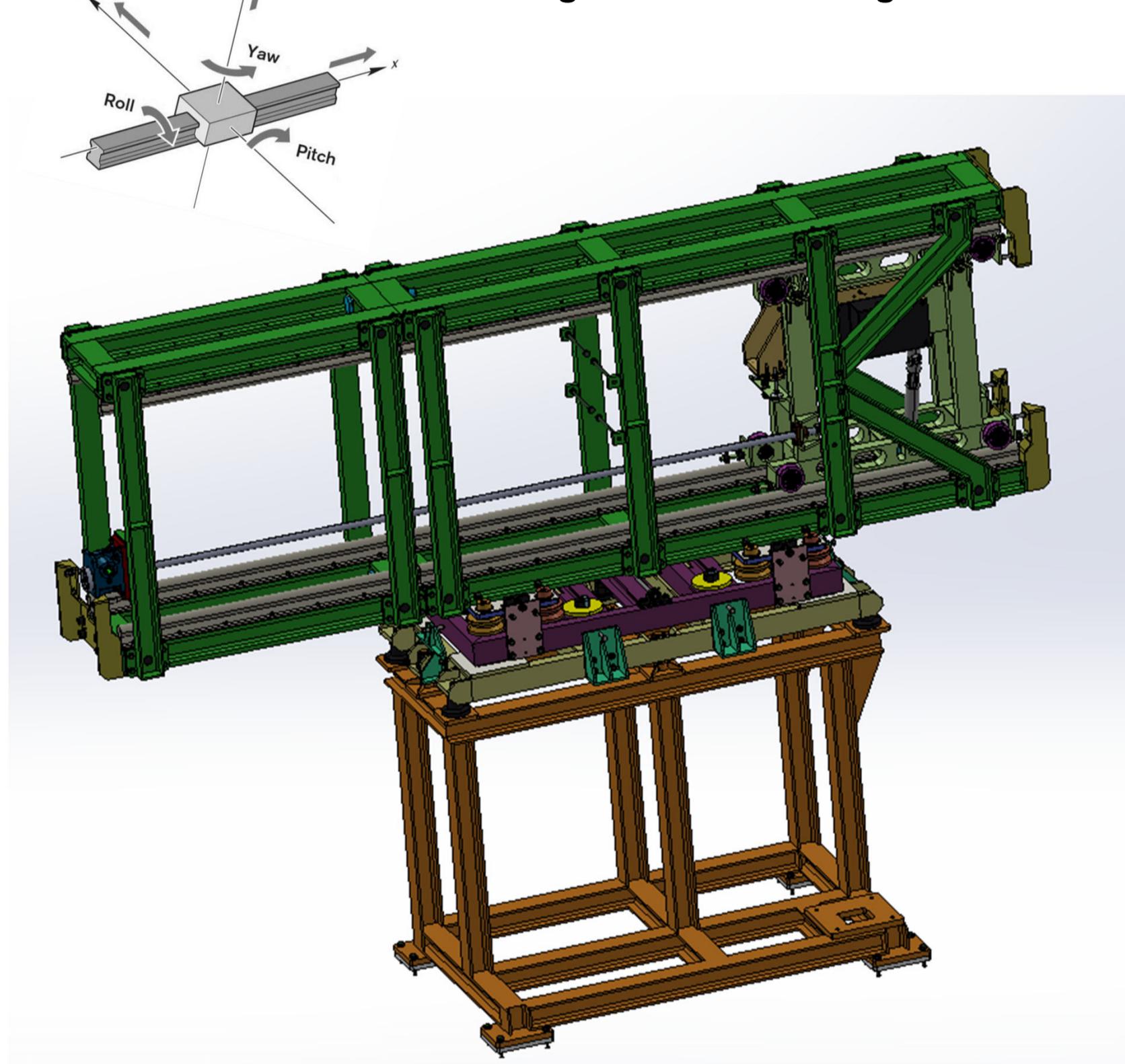


Fig 3. The frames

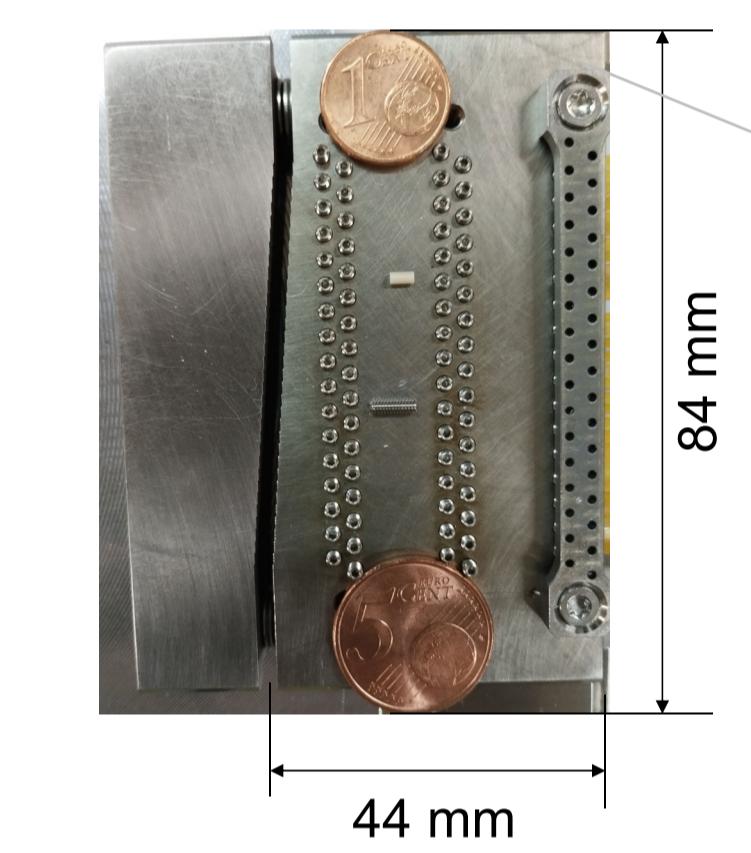


Fig 5. View of the Fibres Holder

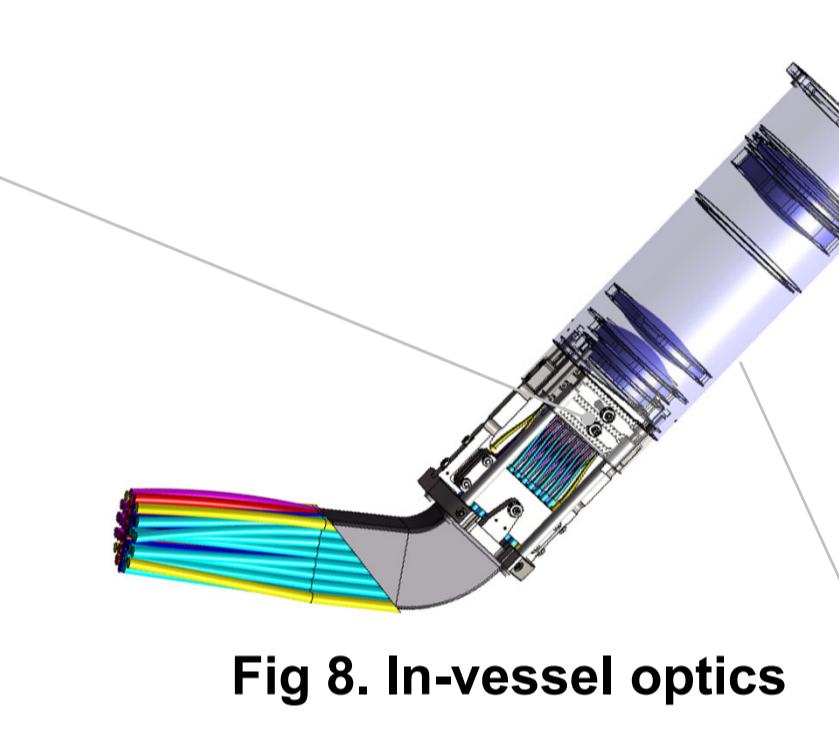


Fig 8. In-vessel optics

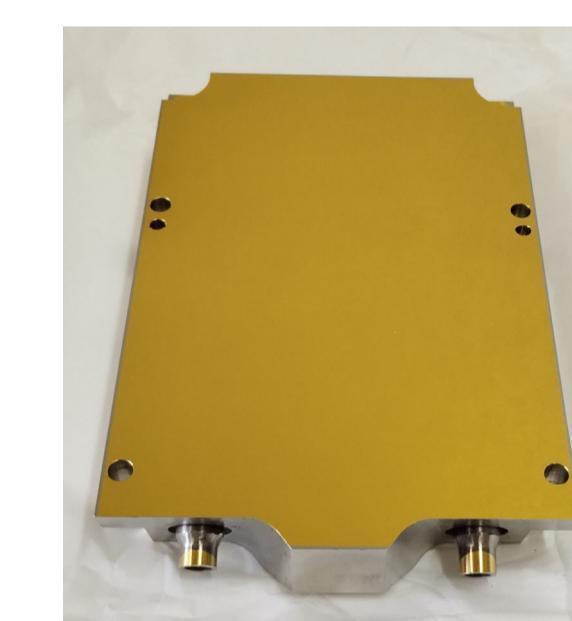


Fig 9. The actively cooled Gold Coated Mirror  
Hot Isostatic Pressing Manufactured

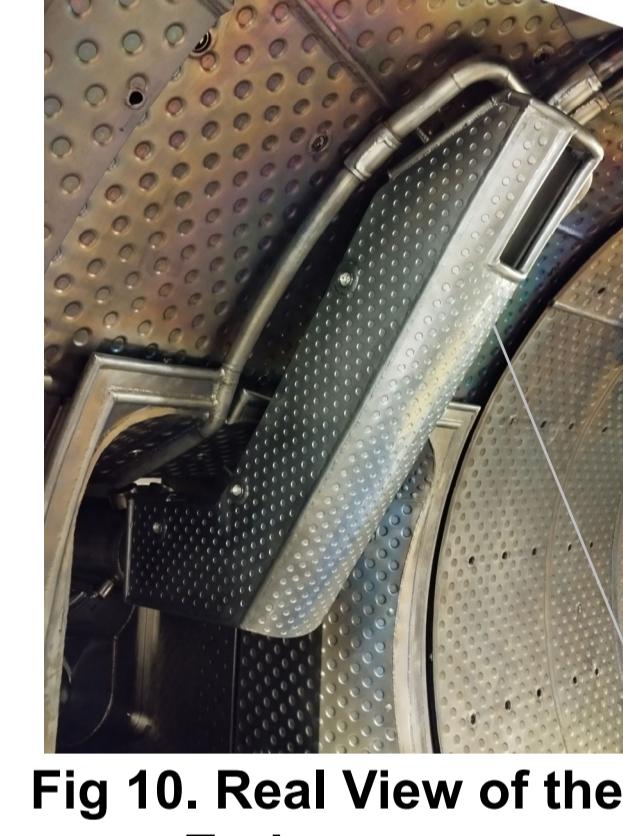
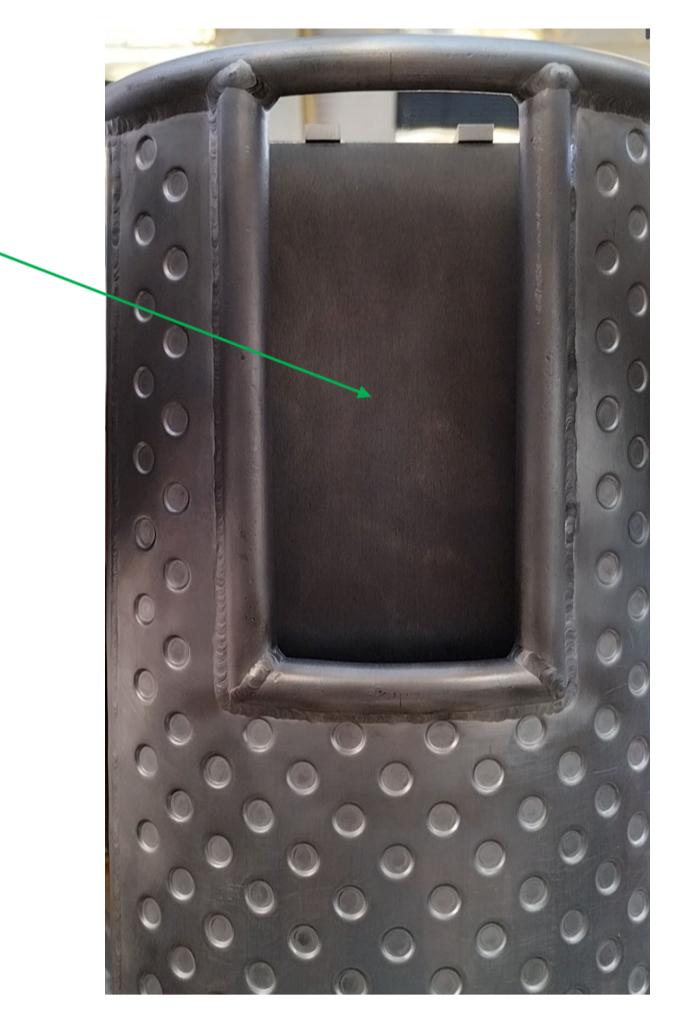


Fig 10. Real View of the  
Endoscope

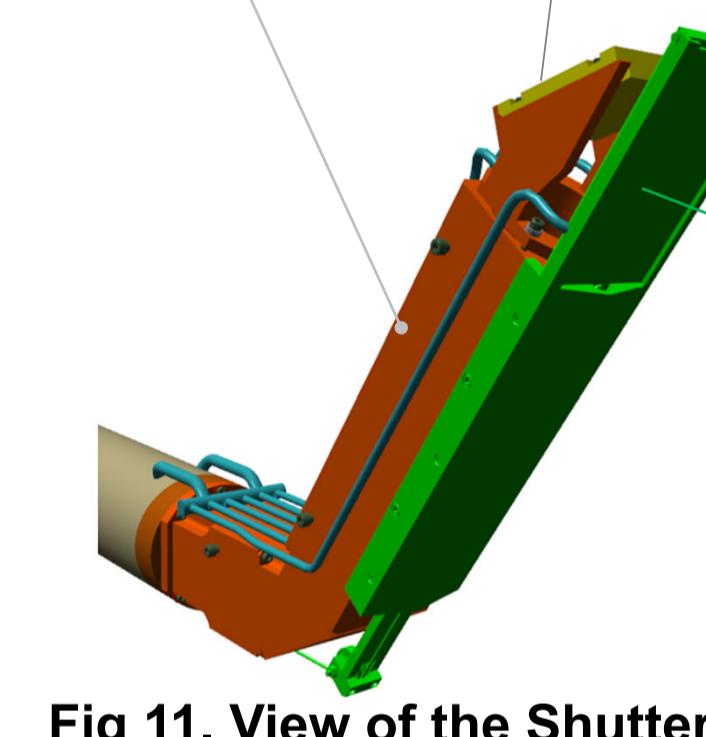


Fig 11. View of the Shutter

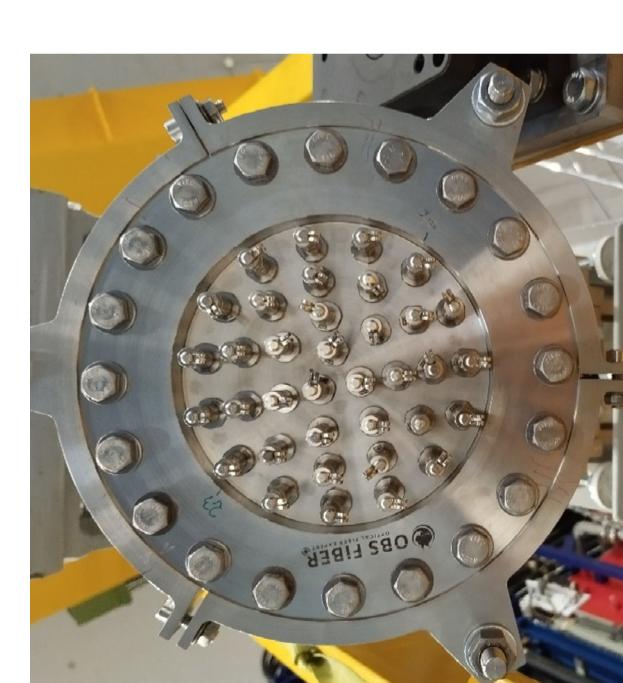


Fig 7. The Optical Feedthrough

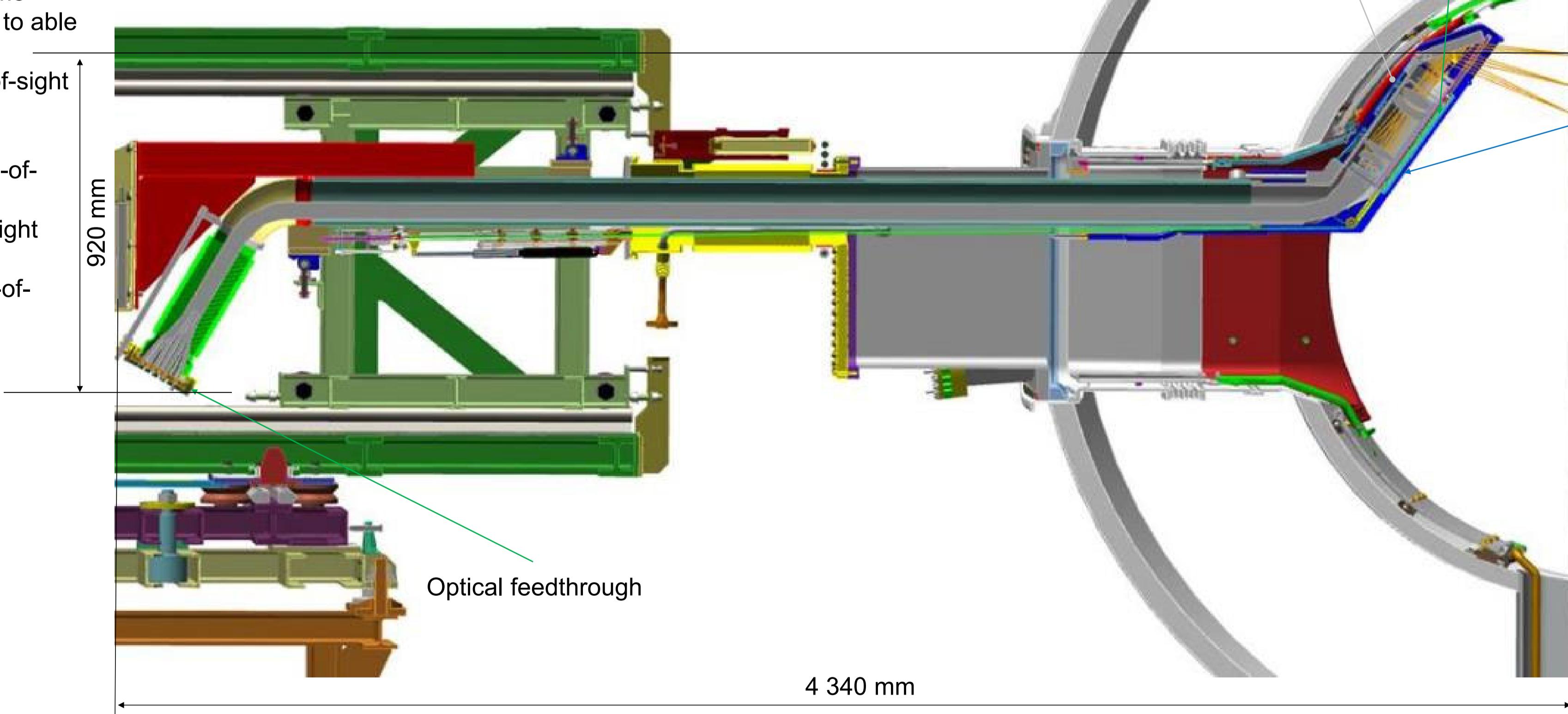


Fig 4. Cross-section of the Endoscope for the Edge Measurement

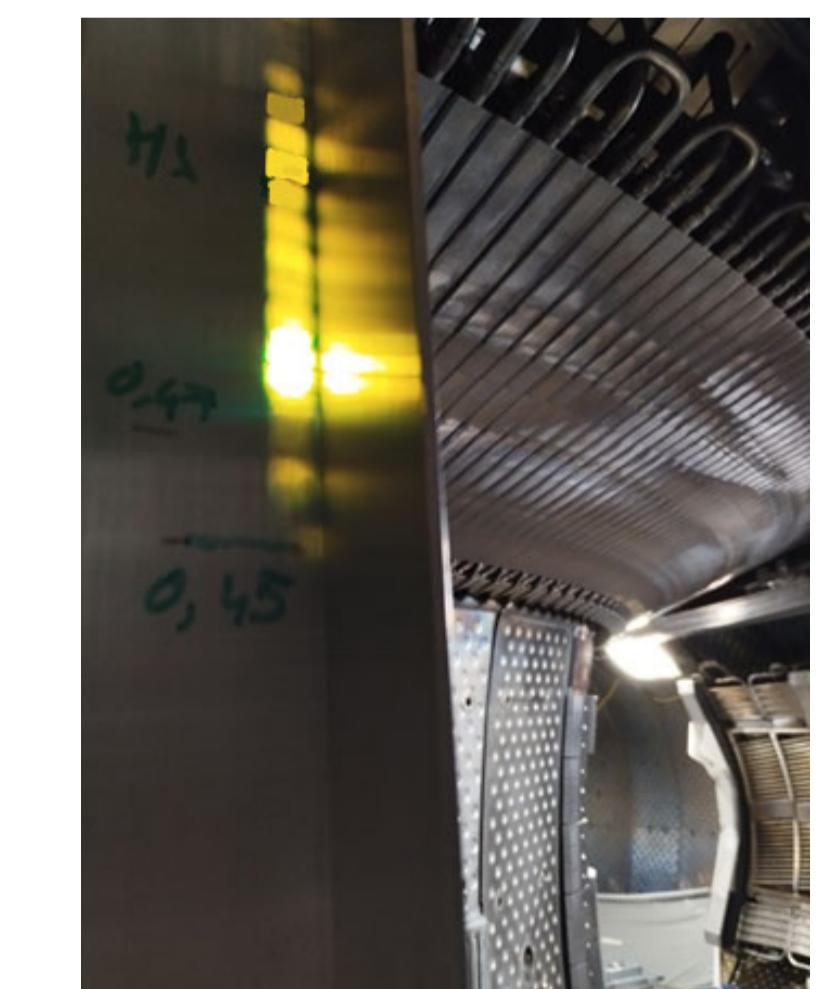


Fig 13. In-vessel alignment

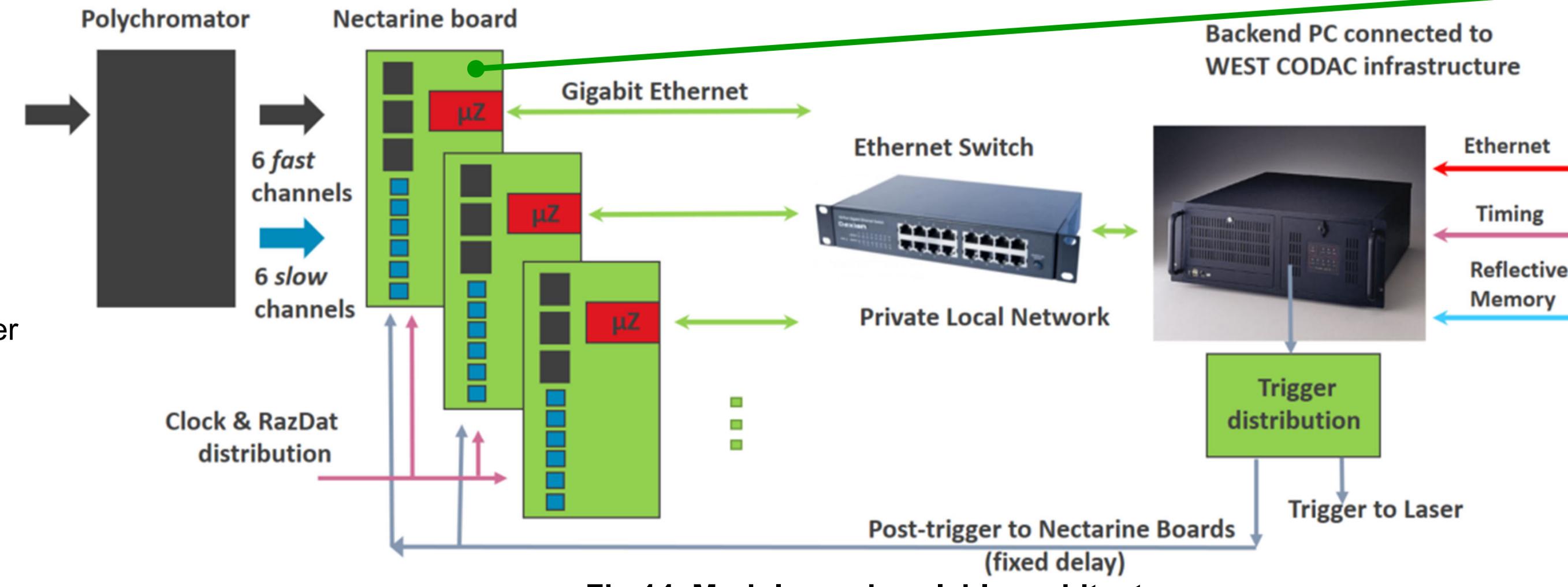


Fig 14. Modular and scalable architecture

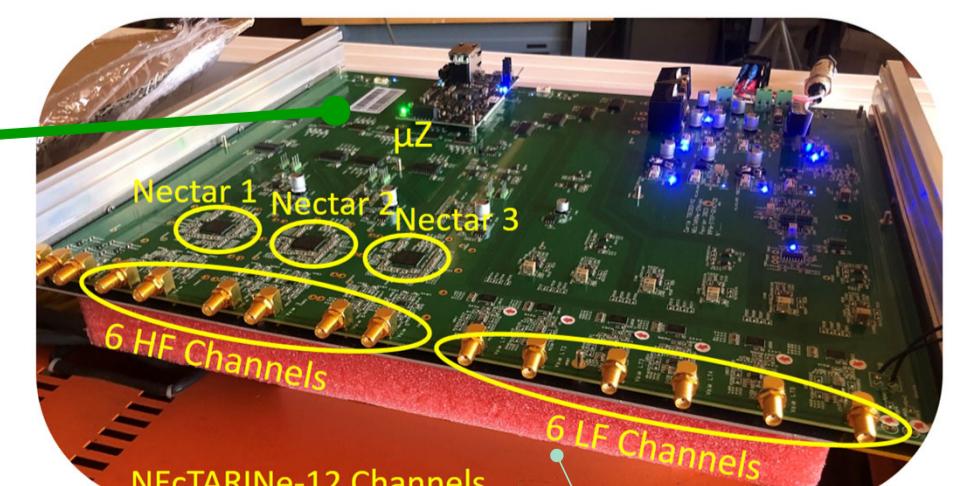


Fig 15. Overall view of the  
Nectarine<sup>(1)</sup> data acquisition board

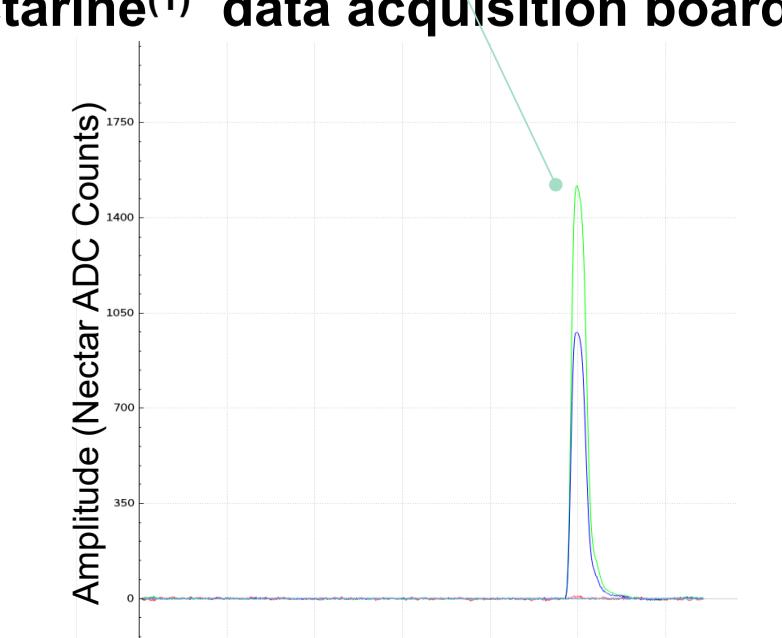


Fig 16. Sample of fast channel acquisition
